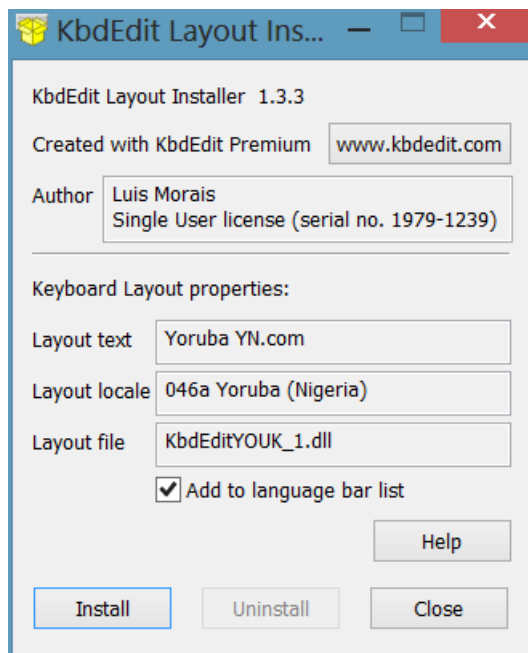


## MANUAL FOR YORUBA KEYBOARD LAYOUT FOR WINDOWS

Thank you for downloading the layout brought to you by YorubaName.com.

All you need to do now is to **double click on the .exe file** and click 'install' (see screenshot below). When the installation is complete, you will receive a confirmation message and YOR – Yoruba (Nigeria) will automatically appear as an option in your language bar. Select your new keyboard layout to type in Yorùbá.



**Follow the instructions below to begin using the keyboard to write in Yorùbá (or your desired language).**

### SUBDOTS

To add a dot under e, s, and o: ALTGR + letter (e.g. ALTGR + o to type ọ).

Capital s, e or o with subdot: SHIFT + ALTGR + letter (e.g. Shift + ALTGR + s to type Š)

### TONE MARKS

High tone (mí): ALTGR + h (e.g. Type the vowel, and then type ALTGR + h)

Low tone (dò): ALTGR + l (e.g. Type the vowel, and then type ALTGR + l)

Mid-tone (macron): ALTGR + m (eg type n and then ALTGR + m to make ñ)

### NOTE:

- \* The layout is customised for languages, like Yorùbá, which make use of the acute accent [á] and the grave accent [à] to realise tone, as well as subdots [ọ, ẹ, š, etc] to differentiate vowels.
- \* All the keys remain the same as on the regular U.S. keyboard
- \* Tone marks are inserted after the letter.
- \* Some fonts accommodate tone markings and subdots better than others, so if the letters aren't looking aligned with the accents, you may want to try changing the font.
